














GETTING HERE




Zagreb Yearly Weather Summary

Zagreb has a continental climate and four distinct seasons with hot and dry summers, cold winters and wet autumn.

The summer months in Zagreb are hot with temperatures averaging around 20 degrees Celsius across the season (June to August) however during July and August temperatures can reach a peak of around 26 degrees Celsius. There is little to no rainfall and the heat can be quite close with little reprieve.

In autumn the temperatures of summer turn colder though they are still quite pleasant. The fog and rain does cool the temperature of the city considerably on some days and it can be difficult to predict what the weather will be like from one day to the next.





The winter in Zagreb starts in December and ends in March and is a slightly longer season than all the others. The temperature during the winter months can get as low as 1 degree Celsius on average with temperatures often going down as low as -4 degrees Celsius in January and February. Snowfall is very common during the winter months.

Spring is the nicest time of year in Zagreb but is also the shortest season only lasting from April to May with temperatures that can get as warm as 30 degrees Celsius towards the end of May. The season is remarkably dry and warms up very quickly.
